Bud Hurlbut of Buena Park was an entrepreneur, innovator, designer, and unsung giant of the amusement park business. Locally, he's best remembered for the many rides he designed, built and operated for Knott's Berry Farm, including their Log Ride and Calico Mine Ride. His ideas inspired Walt Disney and others, and were key in shaping today's modern amusement parks.
